

# Burncrooks – Water Improvement Project

<p>Following on from our previous update in September, please find the latest update on progress with the Burncrooks Water improvement project.</p> <p><b>Ground Investigations</b> Ground investigation to confirm the design and final pipe route is almost complete. This initial phase of investigations took place on private land and adjacent to some pathways. Further groundwork may be required in the next few weeks however these will also be on private land.</p> <p>Borehole investigations at Allander Water have still to be carried out.</p> <p>Vegetation surveys have now been completed. The treatment of invasive weeds on various areas along the pipeline route were also completed in September.</p> <p>Tree surveys will be carried out in Mugdock Country Park SSSI (site of special scientific interest) week commencing 29<sup>th</sup> Oct. This is to ascertain the trees that may need to be removed along the route of the pipeline installation. This tree removal will be carried out in agreement with East Dunbartonshire Council, Scottish Natural Heritage and Mugdock Country Park.</p> <p><b>Planning Applications</b> Planning permission for Bankell Pumping Station was granted on the 18<sup>th</sup> September 2018. Planning for the pumping station at Craigton will be submitted late 2018. Information on these will be available on the planning application section of East Dunbartonshire Councils' Webpage.</p> <p><b>Project Timescales</b> Planned start on site has now changed to early January 2019 however preliminary site set up at Bankell will take place in the coming weeks.</p> <p>We will continue to provide regular updates to the local community and stakeholders as we work towards delivering this important project, which will improve services to more than 54,000 customers.</p>
