



# Glenfarg Water Treatment Works (WTW) Project Update

**Welcome to our latest Glenfarg WTW newsletter. We hope this will bring you up to date and inform you of the steps we will be taking in the coming months.**

### Planning application

The conditional planning consent was granted by Perth and Kinross Council in March. We are now working on the information required to discharge these conditions, including updating the Construction Traffic Management Plan which has been shared with stakeholders to allow us to take on board any feedback.

### Community Liaison Group

We have recently held the sixth Glenfarg Community Liaison Group meeting and we hope you are finding this a good way to express your views on the project. Please feel free to raise any issues that you may have with the community council for them to pass the information along to us.

### Air Curtain

The delivery of the unit which houses the mechanical and electrical components of the “air curtain” was completed in November and works are underway with commissioning ongoing throughout early 2025.

### Access Road Improvements

The road improvements will commence on the **6th January 2025** for a period of 3 months, where daytime closures on Church Brae will be required to allow BT to carry out cable protection on the verges. ESD will then follow to carry out verge improvements and vegetation pruning. **Diversions will be in place between 08.00 and 17.00, Monday to Friday.** The diversions at the bottom of Church Brae in Glenfarg village will lead you through Duncruevie to the junction at the top of church Brae and the private road. Diversions signs will be in place to assist, but please allow more time for your travel. The only exception to the closures is to allow the school bus, tankers, bin lorries and the postman through at the set times as agreed.

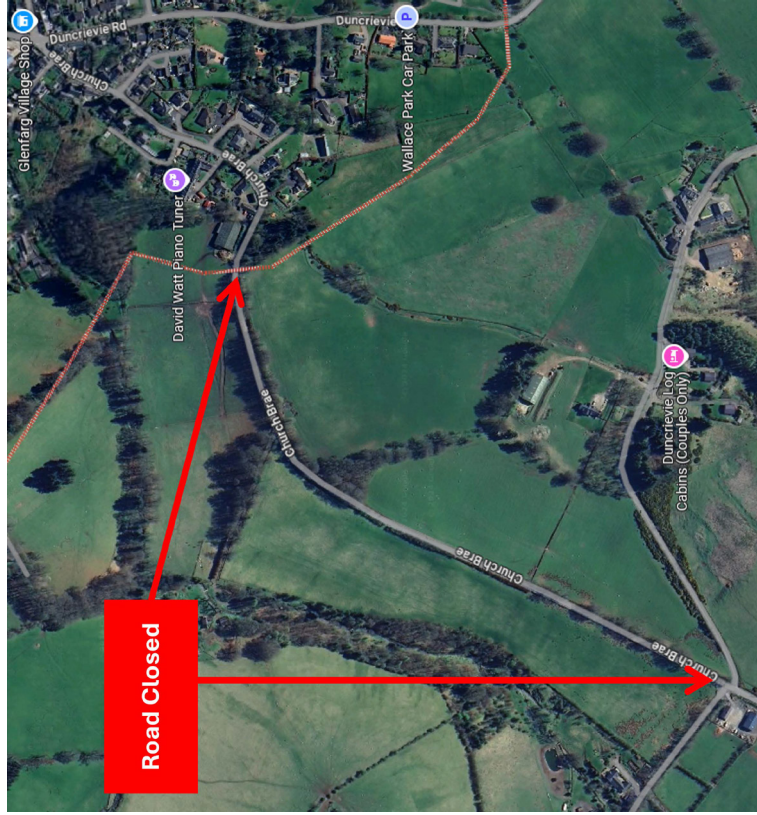
### What is happening next

Early in the new year a new haul road to the north of the farg will be constructed along with a temporary bridge inclusive of utility works and continued improvements to the private access road. These improvements are to improve passing places, verge improvements and vegetation pruning.

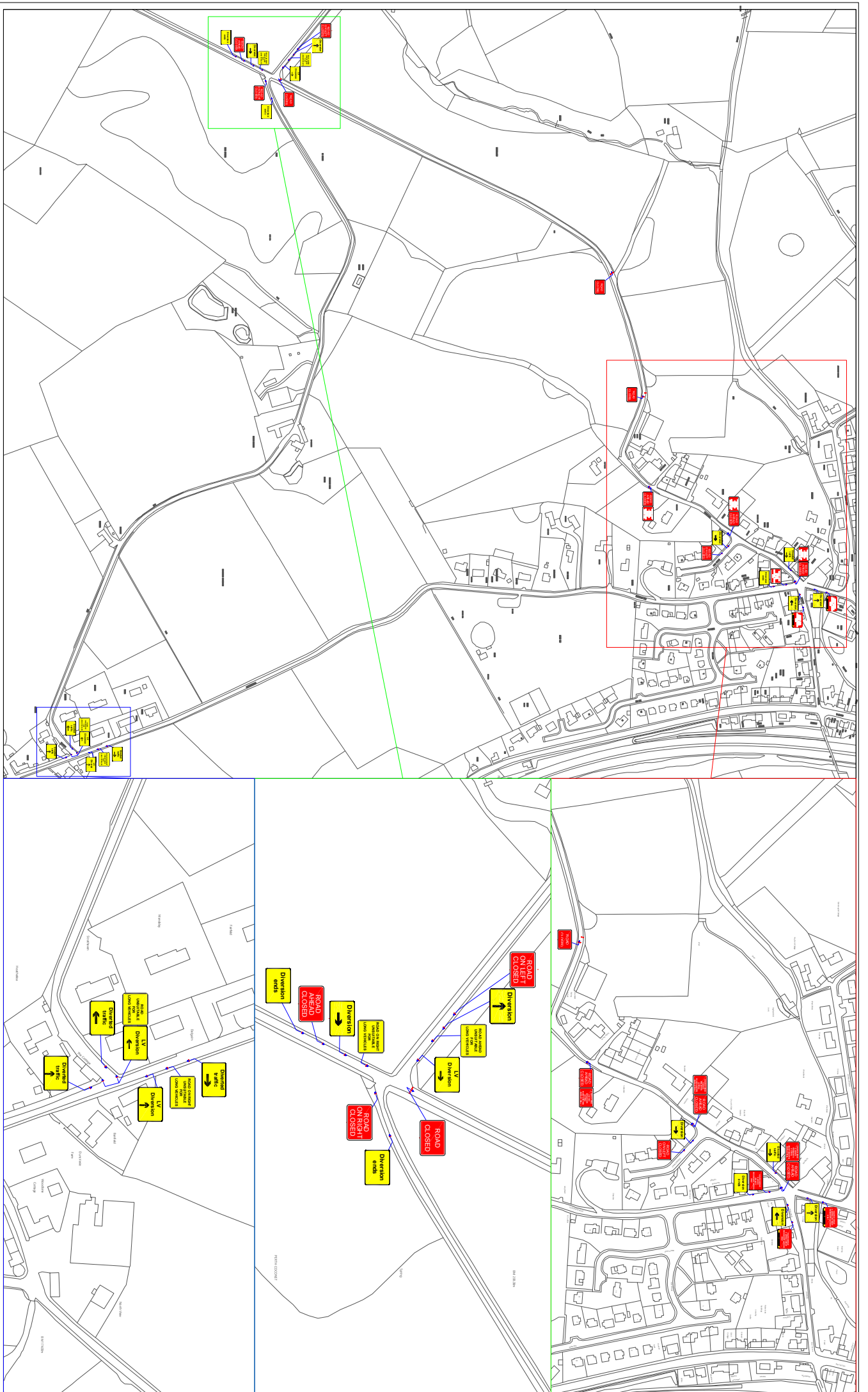
